## **Did You Know That . . .**

- New York State ranks #1 among the states with an average teacher salary of \$70,785, up 9.4 percent from 2008-2009.
- New York ranks 9th in the nation for average beginning teacher salary, at \$48,520, from 2007-2008.
- New York is one of only 22 states where the increase in average teacher salary has kept pace with the national rate of inflation.
- New York State compares favorably with other states in average teacher salaries (selected comparisons below).
